Today, our integrated program continues to help people who are struggling with alcohol and drug addictions and various mental health concerns.

Our staff is kindhearted, engaged, and dedicated to helping people recover, and they ensure that each guest who comes to us to heal truly feels that they belong. The Program

We provide a full range of services for the guests who turn to us in their time of need, including inpatient programming, cooccurring treatment, as-needed detoxification services, and transitional support. All guests who heal at Duffy's must have a primary substance use disorder diagnosis, but you or your loved one can receive support for other mental health concerns while in our care through our co-occurring programming. Our unique curriculum and compassionate team provide our guests with effective recovery tools that help them build a foundation for lasting sobriety.

The Place

Duffy's sits on a former hot spring resort at the base of the maiestic Mount Saint Helena in Calistoga, California, Our 23acre campus is located in the northern part of the beautiful Napa Valley surrounded by serene mountain views, providing our guests with a tranquil setting that helps them reset from the stressors of everyday life.

The environment at Duffy's inspires our guests to experience rest and rejuvenation, allowing them to focus solely on their recovery goals during their stay with us. When guests come to Duffy's for support for addiction and co-occurring mental health concerns, they find a homelike atmosphere that encourages lasting healing.

Treatment Options

We offer a robust array of treatment programs accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF) to help our guests achieve a lifetime of sobriety. We personalize each individual's experience at Duffy's so that they engage in the treatment options that are the most effective for their unique preferences and needs.

Our Foundational Program is ideal for guests who are just beginning their recovery journeys and includes the services and support our guests need to establish a solid foundation for long-term sobriety. This program features a balanced schedule that incorporates psychoeducation classes, experiential therapies, group therapy, and individual counseling. We complement this programming with holistic services such as yoga, tai chi, and meditation.

We recommend our Extended Care Program for guests who are further along in their recovery journeys. This specialized track is a highly personalized experience that allows guests to engage in deeper therapeutic work in smaller group settings. We help our guests identify their specific treatment objectives so that they can work on their unique recovery goals in a safe, therapeutic environment. This program features weekly individual counseling. weekday process groups, daily psychoeducational classes and activities, and support groups.
