WHAT IS CHEMSEX?

The term chemsex is used to describe the use of illicit drugs during sex to enhance experiences, increase stamina, and reduce inhibitions. Typically, chemsex involves the use of drugs such as methamphetamines, cocaine, gamma-hydroxybutyrate (GHB), ketamine, and ecstasy. In addition to being linked to higher rates of HIV and other sexually transmitted infections, chemsex can lead to a range of physical and psychological challenges, including addictions, mental health concerns, and, in the worst cases, overdose.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Duffy's Napa Valley Rehab is pleased to announce the opening of a new specialty chemsex track, which is a response to the growing needs of our clients who are struggling with either chemsex or out of control sexual behavior (OCSB). The program curriculum covers topics like the OCSB model, chemsex, and how addictions can develop as a result of chemsex practices.

With this specialty track, we aim to celebrate individual choice, culture, and pride in the community while also addressing the risks associated with chemsex. Our hope is to provide clients with the support and education they need to be successful after treatment by addressing the complexities of sexual health in early recovery.

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PROGRAM CURRICULUM

With guidance from a certified holistic sex educator (CHSE), program participants work through a series of modules that are designed to promote long-term recovery from substance use.

Modules include:

- Love in recovery module: Clients conceptualize love as a capacity of the self as opposed to an external force.
- Communication & boundaries module: Clients learn about how their ability to communicate effectively & set healthy boundaries can be influenced by relationship structure & sense of self.
- Sexual function in recovery module: Clients learn about sexual function in recovery & how to manage challenges.
- Safe & sane ideal module: Clients begin to shape a personal ideal for future relationships & sexual behavior
 & learn how to use past experiences to make healthier decisions in the future.
- Chemsex & OCSB module: Clients identify the differences between OCSB, sex addiction, chemsex addiction,
 & an active libido & sex life so that they are empowered to apply learnings to their own behaviors.
- Recognizing relapse risk module: Clients develop the ability to connect sexual situations with the level of risk for relapse.
- Myths of dating & relationships in recovery module: Clients learn to apply sexual health skills to dating & relationships.
- Sexit plan module: Clients begin to make plans to protect & care for their sexual health after treatment.
